Seed



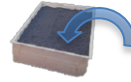
Seedling

Regular
18 gal./week per box



Plant inside garden box



Plant 12-18 inches apart

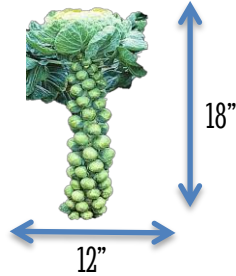
Harvesting

Average time in ground:

27 weeks

Germination time:

3-10 days



Average plant size

Ready to harvest when:

When sprouts are firm

Average time to first harvest:

20 weeks from seedling



How to harvest:

Start harvest from the bottom of the plant. Cut off sprouts at stem, remove lower leaves when sprout begins to form.

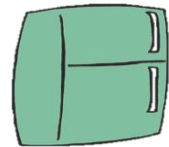
