Seedling

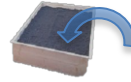


Full sun

Plant 2-3 feet apart

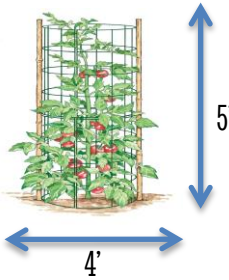
Harvesting

Average time in ground:

28 weeks

Germination time:

7-14 days



Average plant size

Ready to harvest when:

Firm but somewhat tender

Average time to first harvest:

20 weeks from seedling



How to harvest:

Cut or gently twist off fruit

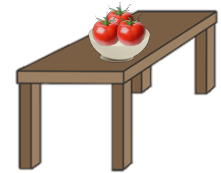
